Pet Section: Entries may be made in advance via email or on the day. All hamsters to be entered by 12.30pm.
Judging starts at 1pm.

- D1. Normal Campbell

- D7. Normal Roberovski

Duplicate Classes All Hamsters to be entered into one of the straight classes before duplicating

- D11. Junior (*all Juniors to be under 16 yrs*)
- D12. Young Stock (*aged 6-16 weeks for Campbells and Winter Whites and 8-16 weeks for all other species*)
- D13. Breeder (*exhibitor to have bred Hamster*)
- D14. Grand Challenge (must enter to be awarded COM)

Special Class

- D15. Non-Standard (*hamster can only be entered into this class, no duplicates*)

Pet Section (judged on tameness and condition)

- P1. Pet Syrian Hamster

Hamsters entered into pet classes may not be entered into any other class

Entry Fees: Straight Classes (1-10, 15, D1-D11 and D15) 25p/entry. Duplicate Classes (11-14 and D11-14) 5p/entry. Pet Classes (P1 and P2) £1 per entry. All labels are to be collected at the show. No hamster to be removed before end of the show without Show Secretary's permission.

All the above Classes MUST be exhibited in the approved Show Pens

All labels are to be collected at the Show. No Hamster to be removed before the end of the Show without the Show Secretaries permission.

All entries (including those withdrawn on the day of the show) must be paid for.

All Show Hamsters to have a small amount of fresh fruit or vegetable and a small dog biscuit (supplied by the Club) and

MUST be placed in the Show Pen before benching. Pet Hamsters to be entered in secure carriers with food and a water source. No Pet Hamsters to be entered in cages. Non-Standard and Pet Hamster entries cannot be entered in any other classes

Show Pens: Subject to availability £1.00 each. Must be ordered with Entry. No more than one Syrian or two Dwarf Hamsters per Show Pen. Borrower to supply shavings for Short-Haired Syrians and Dwarfs or wood-based cat litter for Long-Haired Syrians. Please remove all contents and label before returning at the end of the Show.

Trophies and Rosettes: Rosettes to be awarded to BIS & RBIS. Prize cards awarded for first four places, all classes.

No prize money.

Pet Section: All entrants in the pet classes must be over 10 weeks of age, and have been owned by the exhibitor for a minimum of 7 days.
